She was President of the Waimate Caledonian Games for a number of years and was instrumental in keeping the games going through tough times.

She has officiated at many National, Regional and Sub Centre meetings. She has been Meeting Manager at Lovelock Classic Children's meets and at most sub centre run inter club competitions and usually at the South Island Masters Games. She has officiated at Aoraki and Secondary School championships in Timaru and has been the Meeting Manager for the Aoarki Secondary Schools Championships in 2019.
