How does this works

 To find out what's on go to the Athletics Canterbury website (https://athleticscanterbury.org.nz) and CLICK on EVENTS.



2. **Scroll down** until you find the event and **CLICK** on the date.



3. On each Interclub meeting page, you will find information about the entire season.

4. All competitors pay a **COMPETITION fee**.

SENIOR INTERCLUB COMPETITION FEES

Grade 14 - U16 / Para U17 = \$5.00

U18 / U20 / Para U20 / Masters 65+ = \$8.00

Senior / Para Senior / Masters 35-64 = \$10.00

A \$1.00 per event fee has been introduced to cover admin setup costs

- 5. **LATE ENTRIES** on the day will be accepted in most events, provided there are lanes available.
- 6. An additional \$5.00 late fee applies.



How to use GAMEDAY (Online Entry System)

This is the same system used for club registrations, so it should recognise your email address and possibly your password for your have used it before.

- If this is the first time using the system, type in your **e-mail address**, then **click 'FORGOT?'** to set your (or reset if forgotten) your password.
- Once your e-mail address and password are filled in, LOGIN and follow the instructions accordingly, selecting the corrent Member type' and your events.



3. Only ALL TRACK events require a **QUALIFICATION STANDARD** to be entered. This helps with seeding the event.

SS.TSHS means a time involving only seconds, such as 12.36 for 100m. (Note ONLY a decimal point is used)

MM:SS.TSHS is a time that includes minutes and seconds, such as 2:08.53 for an 800m race.

Athletics Canterbury Time: SS.TSHS \$ 1.00 NZD

(Note the use of a colon after the minutes and decimal point after the seconds)

You DO NOT need to add qualification distances for jumps or throws.

4. TEAM Code is required and it refers to the four letters used to identify your club. CLICK on the ? if you are not sure. Example: CHAV = Christchurch Avon It is important that you get this correct.
