Club Race Entry Instructions 2024

Thank you for being the club race secretary for 2024. We hope this will be a fulfilling experience. These instructions have been created to assist all of us ensure the season goes as smoothly as possible. The CC&R committee reserves the right to change race times, so all club race secretaries should check the event websites for start times before each event. These websites can all be accessed via www.athleticscanterbury.org.nz/competition/events/

Race Numbers & Registrations 2024

We are continuing to use competition numbers for each of our events this year and these will be supplied for each event.

The race organisers will also assume runners are registered if entered by a club unless otherwise notified. In the case of championship events should a runner be later found to not be registered at the time then the race organisers may nullify the runners' right to the medal.

1. At Individual Races (except GB2L)

- **Registered runners** will be allocated a number from 101 to 500 based on alphabetical club and alphabetical name.
- Pins are issued to each number the first time the number is used. These are to be left on the number when returning them.
- Clubs must collect and return the whole pile of numbers together with the timing chips, if used, in numerical order to the Info Table at the start / end of the day.
- Non-registered Runners will be allocated a Community Runner number starting at 2001 and a timing chip if used. These should also be collected / returned to the Info Table.

2. At Governors Bay to Lyttelton

- Registered runners must pick up their number and race chip from the registration
 desk at least 15 minutes before their wave starts. Both the number and chip must be
 dropped in the boxes provided at the end of the race.
- Non-registered Runners will be given a personalised "No Need To Return" race number starting at 2001. They will also get a timing chip. Timing chips will be collected in the finish shute, but the number doesn't need to be collected.

3. At Interclub Relays

• Team sets of relay numbers will be used and returned.

4. At Loburn Road Relay

Sets of races numbers will be issued and they don't need to be returned

- Club and Event name should be at the top of the sheet
- Entries must be submitted by the due day as listed under the Race calls below or be subject to late entry conditions below.
- Non-registered club runners are welcome to run in an event. They pay the community runner fee. Put **COMM** in the NOTES column.

2. Club entries for relays:

- Entries should be submitted via the form on the event websites and / or under the Race Call.
- Unregistered club members and community runners associated with the club are welcome to run in club relay teams. Put COMM in the NOTES column, and pay the community runner fee.
- 3. The race fees listed in this booklet refer to registered runners. Refer to the websites for community runner fees.
- 4. We recognise things happen so at some events late entries will be taken. These are for any entry required after the entry due day. These entries will ONLY be taken on the day and people entering this way must either bring cash or be able to pay into the appropriate bank account on the day
 - a. For events run by the CC & R committee entries will attract a \$20 fee for those 18 years and older and \$10 for U18. Payment is required before the entry is taken. NO EXCEPTIONS.Payment can be made into the Athletics Canterbury Bank account: **03 1592 0086884 000**
 - b. For events run by clubs then the clubs can determine whether or not to accept a late entry and fee applicable. Refer to the Race Call details.
- 5. Payments should be made, using the club's name and race name as reference, within a week of the event.
