General Manager's Report – taken as read. The following points were highlighted.

- Partnership & Activation Manager role at NPW: The contract through Sport Canterbury is coming to end in September. CCC have advised that a new role will be introduced, staffed by CCC.
- Indoor Throws Facility: IT has been asked to look into managing this on behalf of Athletics NZ HP. PN
 wants to ensure that we are not up for increased liability and all risk and costs to stay with Athletics NZ.
- Youth Development framework is being put together and as advised through Eddie's report, Habit Health have come on board as a sponsor in this area.
- Submission to the LTP has been done.
- Fundraising & Sponsorship Manager report taken as read.
- With the following resolutions needed:-
 - Aotearoa Gaming Trust for funding to contribute to the cost of purchasing pole vault mats cover for the amount of \$5,000.00
 - New Zealand Community Trust for funding to contribute to the General Managers salary for the amount of \$30,000.00
 - The Lion Foundation for funding to contribute to the General Managers salary for the amount of \$10,000.00
 - TABNZ for funding to contribute to the purchase of a Leica Viva TS13 Automated Total Station for measuring the distances for all throwing events for the amount of \$5,000.00
 - Kiwi Gaming Foundation for funding to purchase medals and hire toilets for the Loburn 68 Road Relay event for the amount of \$2,348.00

Financial Report: - previously circulated. The following points were highlighted.

- **VG** The profit and loss account is looking healthy and that we are in the normal position we expect at this stage of the year.
- Registration fees are coming in but, with rolling 12 month might take a little longer than in previous years to see the money.
- Profit made from NZ Secondary Schools and Golf Day, along with equipment donated to the centre.
- Fundraising target for this financial year is set at \$180,000.
- Need to continue to work on funding and sponsorship, along with now focusing on medium / long term plans of the fundraising strategy plan.

General Business:

- AGM date is set for Wednesday 24th July. Venue tbc
- AS and VG to talk with Tracey (Reviewer) to ensure that all is completed for review purposes.
- Open to the idea of having an intern board member, as we have done in the past. This will need to be communicated to the community.
- AS is attending Athletics New Zealand Centre Leader's hui in early May, in Rotoroa.
- Potential of T&F national events dates changing for next season (24/25). **AS** to discuss this point at hui, along with the value of Athletics New Zealand membership to our members.
- Team from Crater Rim has caught up with AS & IT, and conversation have been initially discussed around sanction fee and whether it can be repackaged depending on what services we can offer the events. IT to follow up.
